ABOUT OUR SCHOLARSHIPS



Landry Hodges, a 2015 Leavenworth High School, Leavenworth KS, graduate and 2020 University of Mississippi alum, was the first recipient of the Barry Dan Harsh Memorial Scholarship in 2016. Landry was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes at 13 and treated at Children's Mercy Hospital in Kansas City, MO, where he received a Brave Box. A Type 1 warrior and cancer survivor, Landry's family, stationed in Ft. Leavenworth for 7 years, cherishes their connection to the KC area. Inspired by their journey, they proudly offer the \$3,000 Landry Hodges Scholarship, now in its 6th year, to a student excelling in community, leadership, academics, and athletics.

Dylan Fansher, the 2021 recipient of the Landry Hodges Scholarship, began giving back as soon as she started college at University of Missouri in Columbia, MO. With support from her family, Dylan's Army Softball Team, and the KC Metro USA Softball Association, she has raised and donated thousands of dollars through an annual softball event since 2021 to support the KWC Brave Box Program. In addition to these contributions, Dylan and her family, Susy, Danny, Celeste, and Ally, have provided scholarships every year since 2021 and are dedicated to delivering Brave Boxes, initiating fundraising events, joining event committees, and sitting on the Kids With Courage Board. Having received a Brave Box as a young girl, Dylan knows firsthand the impact it can have on a Type 1 journey.



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Have Type 1 diabetes
- Be a graduating high school senior or college student
- Be committed to using education to better your life and that of your family/community
- Good academic standing
- Reside in either the state of Missouri or Kansas
- Be a US citizen or legal resident
- Be enrolled as a full time student

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Awards will be given to students who:

- Honor the beliefs of our vision for those we serve - engaged students who just happen to have Type 1 diabetes and have chosen to have a fighting spirit, and not let Type 1 get in their way.
- Are committed to their education
- Demonstrate involvement in activities
- Show commitment to effectively managing their Type 1 diabetes
- Exemplify kindness, respect, hard work, and perseverance
